### **Summer Camps**

#### Flynn O'Hara Uniforms

Flynn O'Hara is the school uniform provider. Dress codes can be accessed in the Parent Portal-School Website. We have a Standard Uniform and Dress Uniform. Dress uniform is not required for Kindergarten until November/December when K students begin attending Mass. ### **Class Supplies**

All supplies can be ordered through the Knowledge Tree-Kidz School Box program sponsored by the Parent's Association of the Lower School (PALS.) This is the most convenient way to order school supplies as all of your son's supplies will be delivered to his classroom before the start of school. ## Tote bag

Due to the size of the Kindergarten cubbies and lockers, students must use the purple and gold SDS tote bag provided by the school. Should you need to replace this bag at any time, a new one can be purchased from the school.

#### Nap materials

All nap items must be manageable for the child. The child must be able to fold it or roll it up and put into their tote or fit it inside of their cubby with the tote bag and door closed. A thin roll-up mat with pillow and blanket attached, small blanket, or small beach towel would be appropriate.

## **Back to School Night**

Back to School Night is scheduled for Thursday, August 8th from 5:00-7:00 p.m. This night is time for you to see your child's classroom a few days before school starts, drop off any materials that you may have, speak with Mrs. Mungle and Mrs. Harrison, see and meet the boys and families of the SDS class of 2028.

### **Kindergarten Meet the Teacher**

Meet the Teacher morning will be held on Monday, August 19th at 7:30 a.m. in your son's classroom. This morning is designed for parents, so the boys will wait in Early Morning Care in the Dining Hall during this meeting.

### First Days of School

The first day of school is Monday, August 12th. The first two days of school for SDS Kindergarten are half-day orientations, August 12 and 13. Your son will be assigned a half-day orientation and communicated to you by email. We will match the same orientation day with your son or daughter in the PK2, PK3, or JK classes.

## Arrival and Dismissal procedures

## <u>Arrival:</u>

Early morning care is from 7:00-7:45 a.m. and is located in the Dining Hall. Morning carline is from 7:45-8:00 a.m. and is located in the circular drive in front of the St. Dominic School off of Avon Rd. Cars are not to be left unattended in the carline lane. Teachers and Safety Corps members will be in the drop-off area to receive the children. Should you choose to walk your son into his her classroom, park in the Independent Presbyterian parking lot at the corner of Walnut Grove and Avon. You can cross over through the walkway into St. Dominic School. Parents may NOT park on Avon Road.

#### Dismissal:

Dismissal is at 3:00 p.m. (except on Wednesdays when it is at 2:15 p.m.) and is located in the circular drive in front of St. Dominic School (same as arrival). Cars are not to be left unattended in the carpool lane. If you choose to walk in and pick up your child from the SDS foyer, please park in the Independent Presbyterian parking lot. Any child not picked up by 3:15 p.m. is walked to EDA, and a drop-in fee is applied.

## **Extended Day Activities**

Extended Day Activities (E.D.A.) is available until 6:00 p.m. and is held in the Dining Hall/SDS playground. A drop in fee is applied for students attending EDA.
